Dear parents,

Thank you for your support over the course of another highly productive and successful term at Straits International School Rawang. We pause today for our spring break, with students returning for the beginning of term 2 on Monday April 13th at the normal time of 07.45.

Term 2 is almost always the shortest term of the academic year, but we have nonetheless filled the last three months with not only our normal high standards of learning & teaching, student behaviour and academic progress, but also a huge number of purposeful events and new initiatives. We have hosted, of course, our wonderful Chinese New Year & Hari Raya celebration assemblies (both of which were accompanied by our now customary Art Exhibitions); our secondary students have delivered – with the greatest of aplomb – our first ever Drama production of *Dream* (based on Shakespeare's *A Midsummer Night's Dream*); alongside our amazing weekly Talent Show auditions, Mr. Nas has also led on our inaugural Poetry Competition, which culminated in an incredible finale a couple of weeks ago; our CCA provision has been bolstered by a number of new sessions, including our Learn English class for parents and our Swimming Masterclass for budding future Olympians; we have delivered workshops for parents on Primary Maths and for students on studying at UK universities; our students have taken part in International Mother Tongue Day initiatives; and, finally, we have welcomed a small group of Korean students into our community so that they can experience life in a high-achieving, fully-equipped and safe Malaysian International school.

Straits International School Rawang aims to sit at the heart of the community it is proud to serve, and we know that we add value to the lives of the young people in our daily care. We very deliberately offer our students opportunities to shine not only academically but also in the many areas of interest that they have, such as Sport, Drama, Music & Art. During term 3, although our focus will turn very much to ensuring that our Year 11 students complete their IGCSE examinations successfully, we will also hold our annual STEAM week (as well as sending our STEAM team to Tenby Penang!); host Sports Days for all students; deliver *Straits Talking* (a showcase of our
