Dear parents,

CCAs will resume in Straits International School Rawang on Tuesday September 23rd, with ECAs returning a day earlier on Monday September 22nd. This allows us to begin our provision during a full five-day week without public holidays present. Following this CP letter, communication to parents will be made by Ms. Sarah which outlines what our CCA provision looks like and how to book online for any sessions.

It is important for parents to know that we have very deliberately made some adjustments to our CCA provision for the new 2025/2026 academic year. In very simple terms, we are aiming for quality rather than quantity. This means that although there may be fewer choices than previously, the sessions available are not only of greater quality and value but also align more closely with our commitment to both ILOS (International Learning Opportunities for Students) and our 5 ISP Pillars, namely [academic achievement](#), [multilingualism](#), [Life Competencies](#), [Future Pathways](#) & the aforementioned [ILOS](#).

ILOS is of huge importance to all ISP schools globally, but it's one of our big priorities this year at Straits International School Rawang for lots of reasons, most notably perhaps because our sign-up rates previously have not quite been where we think they ought to be. ILOS has a great deal of genuinely purposeful personal improvement to offer our students, and they can enrich their daily experiences simply by taking part regularly and making positive contributions to the sessions.
