Dear parents,

Next week, on Wednesday December 10th, we will hold our annual Christmas Celebration Assembly from 13.30 – 14.30. This year's theme is 'Sleigh All Day' and our assembly will feature modern Christmas songs performed by the following cohorts: EY, Year 1, Year 3, Year 5 & KS3.

We very much welcome parents & extended families to this event, of course, and we will be following the usual [sign-in](#) arrangements so that we can ensure that safe capacity limits are maintained in our MPH. In addition, we are also asking visitors who wish to enter our campus to sign a code of conduct which outlines very clearly our expectations of all guests. This includes, for example, an acknowledgment that visitors may not enter classrooms or other learning spaces, and that all adults on campus who don't actually work in the school must be escorted at all times. This additional layer of simple but highly effective safeguarding is in place to offer even greater security to all parents that their children are safe at all times.

Visitors can arrive in our school from 12.30, and we will have our (Parenthesis) Coffee Shop in our parent café area open from this point for the remainder of the school day. We will have stalls open on the ground floor of our campus which parents are welcome to visit, with students having taken turns to also visit earlier in the day. Payment for all items from stalls will be via Vircle – part of our commitment to being cashless on campus – so please refer to updates from Ms. Haifaa & Ms. Uma about how this works.

Wednesday December 10th is also, of course, the final day of term 1, and we have a clear structure for the day ahead. Students in all year groups will have a class-based Christmas celebration from 08.00 – 08.45, with either visits to the aforementioned stalls or normal lessons then taking place before we enjoy the outstanding Christmas Celebration Assembly once lunchtime has finished. There will be no opportunities for unstructured or unsafe parties, and we do not expect any junk food to arrive into our school during the day.
