Dear parents,

On Thursday February 12th, we will hold our Chinese New Year Celebration Assembly from 13.30 – 14.30. This half-term's assembly will feature performances from students from Early Years, KS1, KS2 & KS3.

I am aware that during previous celebration assemblies already this academic year, performances have overran. In order to address this, parents will be escorted to the MPH from the slightly earlier time of 13.15 so that we can ensure that the assembly begins promptly. Visitors can arrive in our school from 12.30, and we will have our (Parenthesis) Coffee Shop in our parent café area open from this point for the remainder of the school day. Should parents also wish to watch the Lion Dance we have scheduled for 08.30 from our parent café area, then they are very welcome to do so.

We very much welcome parents & extended families to our afternoon event, of course, and we will be following the usual [sign-in](#) arrangements so that we can ensure that safe capacity limits are maintained in our MPH. In addition, we are once again asking visitors who wish to enter our campus to sign a code of conduct which outlines very clearly our expectations of all guests. This includes, for example, an acknowledgment that visitors may not enter classrooms or other learning spaces, and that all adults on campus who don't actually work in the school must be escorted at all times. This additional layer of simple but highly effective safeguarding is in place to offer even greater security to all parents that their children are safe at all times.

Our Chinese New Year Celebration Assembly is scheduled to finish at 14.30, and parents are able take their children home with them at this point, although I would be grateful if primary class teachers & secondary form tutors could be informed in advance for obvious safeguarding reasons.

The following day – Friday February 13th – is both a normal day in school for students and our second Open Day for prospective new families of 2026. We have had a huge number of new families join us this academic year already, and we remain open for
