Dear parents,

I hope that all members of our Straits International School Rawang community – those who have been with us for some time now, and those who have only recently joined – enjoyed a safe & restful break of late. Thank you, as always, to parents for their support with another smooth & effective start to a new term.

Our routines & expectations remain unchanged in terms of key aspects such as timings, uniform & communications.

School begins each day at 07.45, but students will be able to enter (and be supervised in our parent café area) from 07.00, should that work better for parents. The end of the school day will once again be staggered for different phases throughout the week, and teachers will be present to ensure a safe dismissal at all times.

Straits International School Rawang will continue to be a school with unapologetically high standards of student behaviour, and – as always – I am grateful for your support as parents in ensuring that this is the case. Our rules are simple & fair, and they enable both a calm & welcoming climate and the academic success which our students enjoy because they can learn free from distractions.

A visible sign of a student's buy-in to our school is their adherence to our uniform policy, and – once again – I am grateful for parental support in this area. Our simple expectation with regards to uniform is that all students wear their complete & correct Straits International School Rawang uniform each day (unless they've got PE, in which case it's fine for them to wear their PE kits!)

We will continue to maintain our deliberately open channels of communication between school & home so that you can remain fully informed of what is going on in school, and so that you can reach out to us whenever you have a question or an issue to resolve. The bottom line here is that it should never be difficult for you as a parent to communicate with either a teacher or a senior leader. Primary parents can continue to use Dojo, secondary parents (and primary parents, if they prefer) can email teachers

For the latter, it's better to arrange an appointment in advance as teachers won't be able to leave lessons to speak to parents, but I would accept also that parents have busy schedules and that sometimes urgent matters can arise. Our big communications to you (the weekly CP letter and our primary & secondary newsletters) will continue to be published each Friday. Please make sure that you read both as they very intentionally cover everything you will need to know for the coming weeks.

Earlier this week, we also published our third Curriculum Overviews of the 2025/2026 academic year. These documents are designed for you as parents and will inform you of everything that your child will be learning over the course of term 2.1, so please do take the time to see what will be happening in lessons.

Term 2 promises to be another eventful & positive period in our school. From now until April – and following on from the CCA fair which has taken place already yesterday – we will have mock exams for our Year 11 IGCSE students, the qualifying rounds for our annual Talent Show, celebration assemblies & Art exhibitions for both Chinese New Year & Hari Raya, an exciting partnership with a Motorcycle Riding Academy (more of which to follow soon), school photos & a performance of Shakespeare's A Midsummer Night's Dream taking place, to name but some of the standouts. No other schools are adding as much value to their provision whilst also retaining a relentless focus on high academic standards as Straits International School Rawang, and I am genuinely incredibly proud of our wonderful team of highly-committed teachers & other professionals who enable our ongoing success.
