Today is the final day of the second term of the 2024/2025 academic year. Students will return to school on Monday April 21st at the usual time of 07.45. I wish all members of our Straits International School Rawang community a safe and restful term break.

With regards to our plans for further improving our school, term 2 very much followed on from the earlier successes of term 1 which were outlined to you in the [CP letter dated December 13th 2024](#). Over the course of this term, a very positive and productive ISP LIP (Learning Improvement Process) review has taken place, we have launched and made significant progress with our new Learning & Teaching vision, we have established our 'Green Team' to work on our highly important ESG agenda and we have cultivated a number of hugely beneficial long-term partnerships with external providers (such as ICMS – the professional football coaching organisation currently leading sessions on Friday afternoons, Active Learning Academy – who will be running our [summer holiday camp](#) provision, Bluefin – a swimming company who recently sought parental perspectives for future endeavours via Dojo, Selangor Symphony Orchestra – about whom we will publish partnership plans in due course, and Mori Residences, to name but some). In addition, term 2 saw our annual Talent Show – revamped but under the usual magnificent leadership of Mr. Nas – as well as amazing cultural assemblies (led superbly as ever by Ms. Haifaa and aided commendably by our wonderful parent events committee) for both Chinese New Year & Hari Raya take place. From a more academic perspective, we also refreshed our ISAMS parent portal and supported parent access and understanding, and rebooted our Year 9 IGCSE options processes. All of the initiatives above, of course, were made possible by the wonderful appointments of two highly qualified and experienced Heads of School – Ms. Katherine and Mr. Simon for our primary & secondary phases respectively. Much of the clear and positive progress we have made during term 2 has been down to their efforts and expertise, and for this I am certainly very grateful.
